This guide will detail how to create a Player Profile on **SCRUMS**, the Scottish Rugby User Management System.

STEP 1

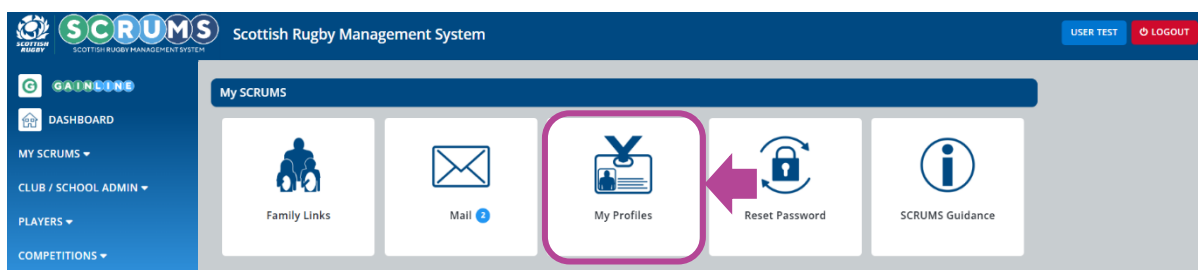
To create a **Player Profile**, please [login to your own SCRUMS Account](#) from the **SCRUMS** main login page [HERE!](#)

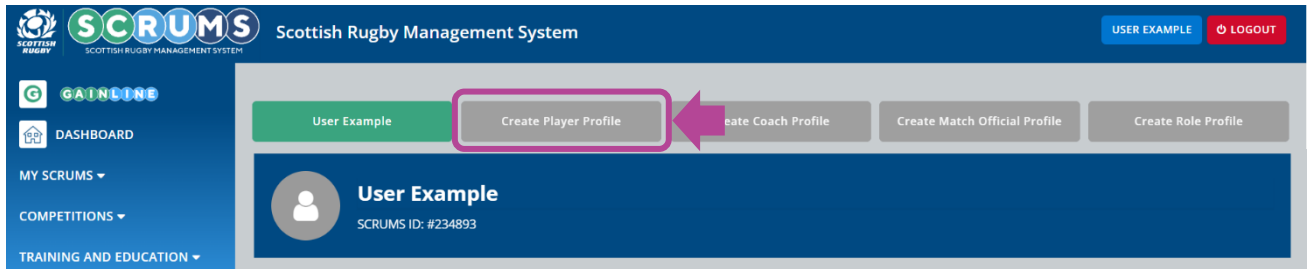
STEP 2

To create a **Player Profile**, click on the **Create Player Profile** tab.

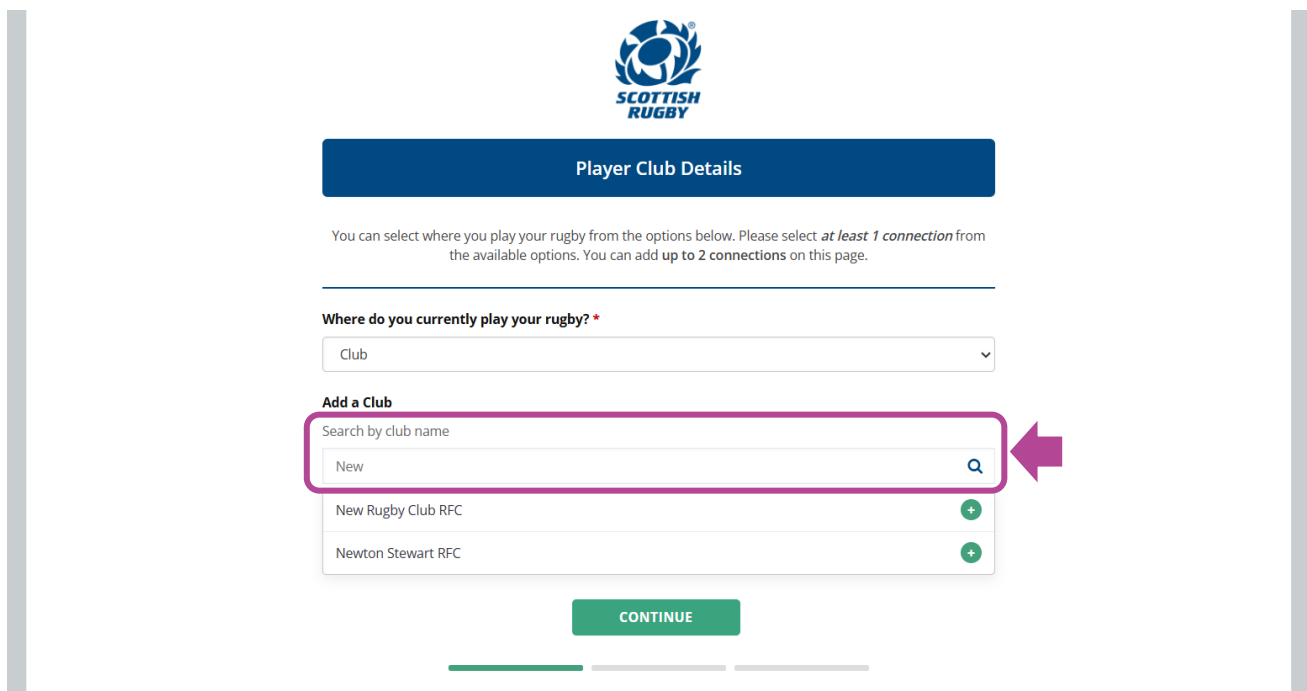


STEP 4

This will open the **Player Registration Form** which contains **3 Sections**.

SECTION 1: Player Club Details: You can select your playing clubs and / or school from the available options. You can add up to 2 connections from this section.

Search for the club or school by typing into the **Search Box**. This will open a drop down for related clubs / schools. Select your club / school by clicking on it.

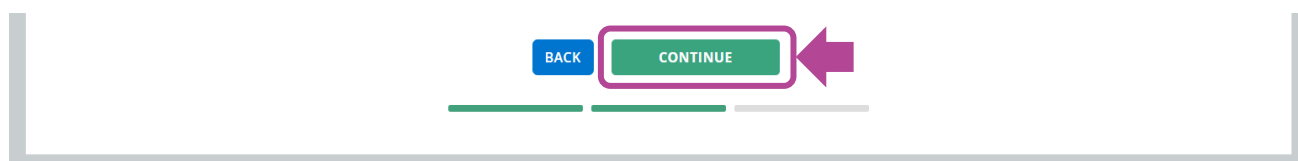

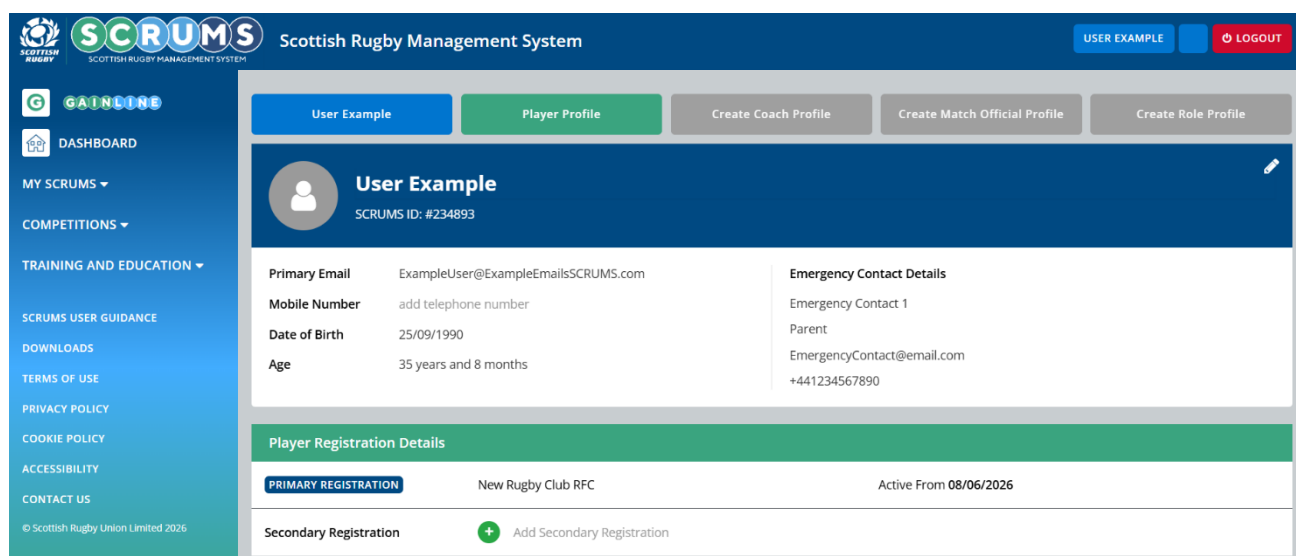
