


This SCRUMS User Guide is to explain how Child Protection Officers at clubs can view coach information in SCRUMS.

STEP 1

The Data Manager, or any other SCRUMS Administrator at your club, needs to assign you the role of Child Protection Officer. Once you have been assigned as CPO in SCRUMS, when you log in, you should see a screen like the one below.

If you have been assigned additional user permissions by the SCRUMS Administrator at your club, then you may have more options than those displayed here.

To access the coach information for your club, navigate to the 'Coaches' section of SCRUMS, either through the sidebar or dashboard, as highlighted below.





STEP 2


You will now see a screen listing all coaches who have registered in SCRUMS with your club.

Coaches with a status of 'Verified' have been reviewed and verified by Scottish Rugby. This is to check that, where required, the coach has the necessary PVG membership with your club and also, that accurate qualification information is held in their record. Those coaches shaded in grey have not yet been verified and cannot be added to your club's 'Active Coach List'.

For verified coaches, the 'PVG' column, indicates whether the coach has the necessary PVG membership with your club to coach youth rugby. If not, this column will state 'Coach adults only'.

A coach must have a status of 'Verified' and the PVG column indicating 'Can coach youth' before they can commence coaching youth rugby.


To view any individual's coach profile, click on their name.





STEP 3

When you click on the coach name, you will view their coach profile;



This screen displays various information about the coach;

- Their name / SCRUMS ID number / DOB (at top of screen)
- Their PVG number
- A note of all clubs / schools that the coach has registered with in SCRUMS
- · Information on qualifications, including Rugby Right
- Information about their coaching role, as entered by the coach when they registered
- The 'Notes' field can be used to record any useful information about the coach and can be viewed / edited by the CPO and any other SCRUMS users with access to the club's coach records (which will be the Club Coach Coordinator and the club's SCRUMS Administrators)



Please Note:

If the coach record has not yet been verified by Scottish Rugby, then the PVG Number on this screen may be blank or will appear as it was provided by the coach when they registered. Once the coach record has been verified by Scottish Rugby, the PVG number will display the correct number.
