

## SO SETUP & NAVIGATION

This user guide will explain how **Safeguarding Officers** at clubs can be setup to view coach information in **SCRUMS**, the Scottish Rugby User Management System.

#### STEP 1

The **Data Manager**, or any other **SCRUMS Administrator** at your club needs to assign you the **Role** of **Safeguarding Officer (SO)** on **SCRUMS**.

PLEASE NOTE: For further details on assigning roles at your club, please refer to the 'Updating Club User Roles in SCRUMS' guide,

Once you have been assigned as a **SO** in **SCRUMS**, when you log in, you should see a screen like the one below.

To access the coach information for your club, navigate to the **Club / School Admin** section from the **Main Menu Sidebar** or **Dashboard Tiles**, as highlighted. Then, click on **'Coaches'** 




**PLEASE NOTE:** If you have been assigned additional user roles & permissions by the **SCRUMS Administrator** at your club, then you may have more options than those displayed here.

#### STEP 2

You will now see a screen listing all coaches who have registered in **SCRUMS** with your club.



Coaches with a status of 'Verified' have been reviewed and verified by Scottish Rugby.

Verification is a check that, where required, the coach has the necessary **PVG Membership** with your club and also, that accurate **Qualification Information** is held in their record.

For verified coaches, the **PVG** column indicates whether the coach has the necessary **PVG Membership** with your club to coach youth rugby. If not, this column will state **'Coaching adults only'**.

**PLEASE NOTE:** A coach must have a status of 'Verified' and the **PVG** column must indicate 'Can coach youth' before they can commence coaching youth rugby.


On the 'All Other Coaches' list, coaches shaded in grey have not yet been verified and therefore cannot be added to your club's 'Active Coach List'.

### STEP 3

To view any individual's **Coach Profile**, click on their name.



The **Coach Profile** screen displays various information about the coach.

- Their name / SCRUMS ID number / DOB (at top of screen)
- Their **PVG** number.

If the coach record has not yet been verified by Scottish Rugby, then the **PVG Number** on this screen may be blank or will appear as it was provided by the coach. Once the coach record has been verified by Scottish Rugby, the **PVG Number** will display the correct number.

- A record of all clubs / schools that the coach has registered with in SCRUMS
- Information on qualifications, including Rugby Right
- Information about their coaching role, as entered by the coach when they registered
- The 'Notes' field.

This field can be used to record any useful information about the coach and can be viewed / edited by the **SO** and any other **SCRUMS** users with access to the club's coach records. (E.g. **Club Coach Coordinator** and the club's own **SCRUMS Administrators**).
