



YOUTH PLAYER COURSE BOOKING

This guide will detail how a parent / guardian registered player can book onto training and education courses on **SCRUMS**, the Scottish Rugby User Management System.

STEP 1

Parent / guardian registered players will have to register themselves on **SCRUMS** to take part in a training course. **PLEASE NOTE:** Youth players must be **14 years old or older** to register themselves on **SCRUMS** or book onto training courses.

To register a 14–17-year-old parent / guardian registered player on **SCRUMS** please contact a member of the **SCRUMS** team at the following email address: scrums@sru.org.uk.

A member of the **SCRUMS** team will then send you an automated email containing a user link. This email will request that the account ownership transfers to the player by allowing them to register themselves on **SCRUMS**.

To provide the **Players** email address and allow them to register themselves on **SCRUMS** click the 'HERE' link in this email, as highlighted.

STEP 1 continued

Then, enter the **Players** email address in the text boxes and click '**Submit**'.

STEP 2

Your child / dependant will now receive an email from **SCRUMS** with a **Registration Link**. This will allow them to register and take control of their **SCRUMS** account.

The **Player** should click '**HERE**' to begin **Registration**.

PLEASE NOTE: The access link will only remain active for **2 hours**. Thereafter, another link will be required.

STEP 3

The Player, upon clicking the **Registration Link** will be asked to read and accept **SCRUMS Terms of Use** and **Privacy Policy** before proceeding to **Registration**.

To proceed, click the **Blue Button** as highlighted, then scroll down the page to click the **'Accept'** button to continue.



To complete **Registration**, confirm the details we hold about you are correct, then, confirm your **Email Address**, as highlighted.

You can now **Book onto Courses** from your **SCRUMS** account.



View more details on each course by clicking on its **Course Tile**.




By the end of the programme, you will:


STEP 7

This will bring you to the **Course Booking** page, navigate to the **Booking** section to view the course price and to see the available spaces.

Book your place by clicking the **Book Course** button.

If there is no course fee to pay, and there are places available, you will be booked onto the course and taken to the **My Course Record** page of **SCRUMS** where you will see details of your course.


If there is a course fee to pay, and there are places available, once you click the **'Book Course'** button you will be redirected to our payment gateway page.



STEP 8

Once your payment has been processed you will return to **SCRUMS** where your **Course Booking Information** will be available to view, along with any **Prerequisite Modules** that require completion before your course date.

Thereafter, you can keep track of any courses you have booked to attend, as well as any others that you have booked onto and completed from **'My Course Record'**.






